

International Week 2011

Theme: Unity

Verse: “How good and pleasant it is when God’s people live together in peace!” (Psalm 133:1) or “There is one body and one Spirit, just as also you were called in one hope of your calling; one Lord, one faith, one baptism, one God and Father who is over all and through all and in all.” (Ephesians 4: 4-6)

The MCL Department is sponsoring a poster/artwork contest for 5th and 6th graders. The student creations should reflect this year’s theme: Unity. All media will be considered. 7th and 8th graders who wish to participate may do so but we are looking for creations from the 5th and 6th graders who normally don’t get a chance to show off their talents during International week. Their entries will be judged as a group.

POSTER/Canvas PREPARATION—Please turn in by Monday, 1/24/2011

The MCL Department will create space to display your creations. There will be small tables available or display walls to show off your work. You may create a poster size-11 inches by 14 inches or an art project on canvas, photo paper, or linen of approximately the same size or smaller. It is recommended that you prepare the art works with sufficiently large fonts and figures so that they can be comfortably read at a distance.

SUPPLEMENTARY MATERIALS

Please **include with your presentation an explanation of what it represents, how you came to create the work, and your sources of inspiration.** This information will be 20% of the final score, so be sure to include the explanation with your work. The explanation should be on a separate sheet of paper with your name and grade level.
