Greetings from Middle School Chorus! If you are receiving this letter, your child is enrolled in MS Chorus for the 2010-2011 school year. In preparation for a special (optional) field trip just as school begins (see below for details), Chorus T-shirts must be ordered over the summer. **Each chorus member must buy a shirt** to use throughout the year; the cost is **\$10**. Please see the attached T-shirt and Gwinnett Braves Game form about when and where to send your check made payable to Wesleyan School.

Now for the BIG field trip news! The Middle School Chorus is singing the National Anthem at the **Gwinnett Braves** game on Saturday, August 28th! This opportunity is open to all Middle School Chorus members. While this is **not a mandatory event**, we would love to have a huge showing. We will **depart** from behind Cleghorn Hall at 5pm. We will travel to the stadium, warm-up, and then sing at approximately 6:50 on the field! After that, we will enjoy the Braves' game vs. the Norfolk Tides and return to Wesleyan at approximately 11pm. Please note that you may order tickets for your whole family through Wesleyan this year. However, only singing students and chaperones may ride the bus. Students also may leave the game with their parents **from inside the stadium with a signed form students will be given the 1st week of school.** Students/families **may not** make this decision last minute.

The cost for transportation and game ticket is \$20. Students should wear their Chorus t-shirts (see attached; shirts will be distributed on Friday, 8/27, in class) and khaki shorts, capris or pants (*shorts should be no shorter than four (4) inches above the knee, as measured from the middle of the back of the knee, as stated in the handbook*).

GENERAL AGREEMENT/RELEASE/WAIVER STUDENT ACTIVITY

- My child, _____, has been given the opportunity to participate in a school trip which is being made available to the students of Wesleyan School. In connection with this trip, I fully realize and acknowledge that, as with any activity and as with any mode of air or ground transportation, injuries are a possibility, and I recognize that, on rare occasions, these injuries can be so severe as to result in total disability, paralysis or even death. Realizing such, and in consideration of my child being allowed to participate in this trip on the date(s) and for the period of time specified below:

- (1) I give my express permission for my child to participate fully in said trip;
- (2) I assume all risks, including any risk associated with any special medical needs or conditions of my child, of participation in said trip;
- (3) I authorize _____ Meg Foster an adult who will participate in said trip to obtain on behalf of my child, at my expense, any necessary emergency medical services which may be required at any time during said trip;
- (4) I certify that I have insurance reasonably sufficient to cover my child against loss of or damage to property, personal injury and loss of life caused to my child or caused by my child in connection with such trip; and
- (5) I agree that all expenses relating to or arising out of any such loss or damage to property, personal injury or loss of life will be my financial responsibility, and my child and I agree to release, hold harmless and indemnify Wesleyan School and its officers, agents, representatives, employees, assigned volunteer coaches and trustees against any and all claims, liabilities, damages and expenses, including reasonable attorney's fees, with respect to any injury to person, regardless of severity, and or loss of or damage to property of any type relating to or arising out of any activities or occurrences on said trip. I further waive the provisions of any law which provides that a general release does not extend to claims, demands and causes of action not known at the time the release is given.
